Farmer extensions in remote areas need to be improved and modernized with the use of digitalized systems. These measures would strengthen the fragile food systems and improve the livelihood of the people in the continent.

In December 2020 16 Strategic Programs of IOFS have been approved by the 3rd General Assembly in Ankara. All of them directly related to our African member states.

At IOFS, we believe that the food we need should be nutritional, safe, Halal and enough for everybody via the modality **Gene to Fork** as a complete ecosystem to achieve this aspirational goal.

It cannot be achieved without the development of strategic commodities of Wheat, Rice, Cassava and Palm Oil among other strategic commodities. We have carefully planned to establish key Centers of excellence to cover most of OIC geographic regions, including North, Western and Eastern Africa. The Centers of Excellence would utilize the latest digital technologies to guarantee its superior performance and sustainability.

Today the international conference will discuss the biodiversity as important approach to achieve resilient food system. At IOFS we are believing that harnessing technology and innovation to enhance Food Security in OIC Member States through agricultural biodiversity is an important approach. IOFS is examining the possibility of deliberating upon a regional mechanism for protection, conservation, exchange of views, human and institutional capacity development with regards to plant genetic resources for food and agriculture in OIC Member States. International workshop in July 2020 has arranged jointly by government of UAE and IOFS Secretariat has reviewed and approved the Framework of Action on Plant and Animal Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (PAGRFA) as a practical step in coordinating intra-OIC action in the field of promoting food security through agricultural biodiversity.

While borders are closed and our travels are restricted, locust has been moving transboundary without any restrictions. At the beginning of 2020, an unprecedented locust outbreak threatened eight countries in the East African region besides Pakistan and Iran in Asia. The estimated loss of crops and livestock was put at US\$15 billion. IOFS program will use the Artificial Intelligent and Remote Sensing to develop interactive platform for predicting, alarming, and controlling the Locust.

In the spirit of including the much-needed engine of our private sectors in food security, IOFS has given tremendous special attention to an amazing flagship project of International IFPA which is a private-sector engaging arm that is dedicated for all our Member States. The International IFPA is a global platform for future interaction between entrepreneurs and all stakeholders in the entire ecosystem as not only does it relate to trade, but it accommodates other issues of business such as technology and information sharing among members, capability studies, increased market access as well as transport and logistics among others. Today, IOFS will present in more detail International IFPA in the session 3.
